Prevalent Medical Conditions

The District School Board of Niagara has policies and procedures regarding students with Prevalent Medical Conditions. If you have a child with a Prevalent Medical Condition (Anaphylaxis, Asthma, Diabetes, and/or Epilepsy or other) we want to make sure we have a current Plan of Care to support your child. It is required that we complete a new Plan of Care every school year.

If you have already indicated that your child has a Prevalent Medical Condition we will be sending new forms home to be completed and submitted ASAP.

In addition to completing these forms we do need to have a quick phone call to review the Plan of Care. In compliance with our school board procedure we would like to have all forms completed and phones conversation within the few two weeks of school.
